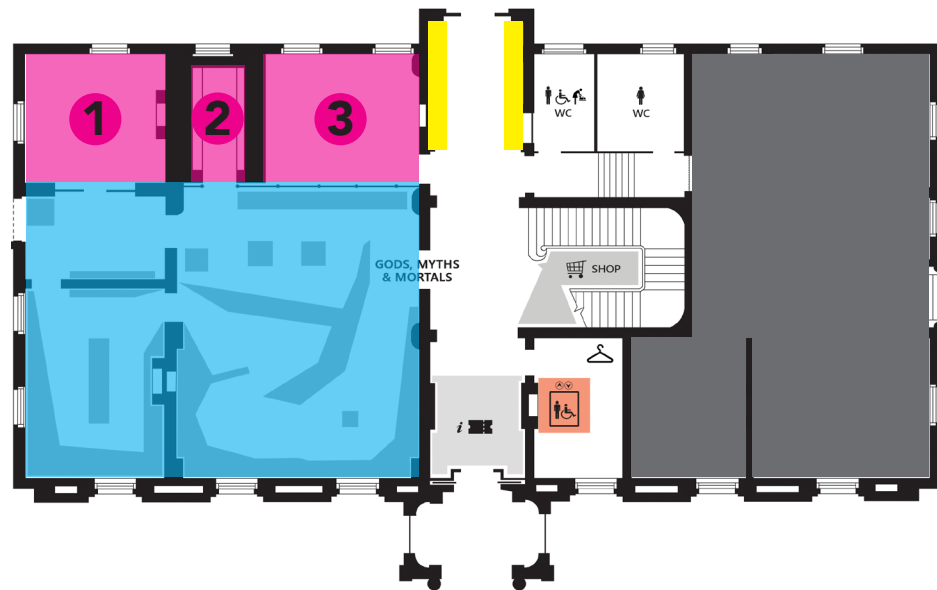
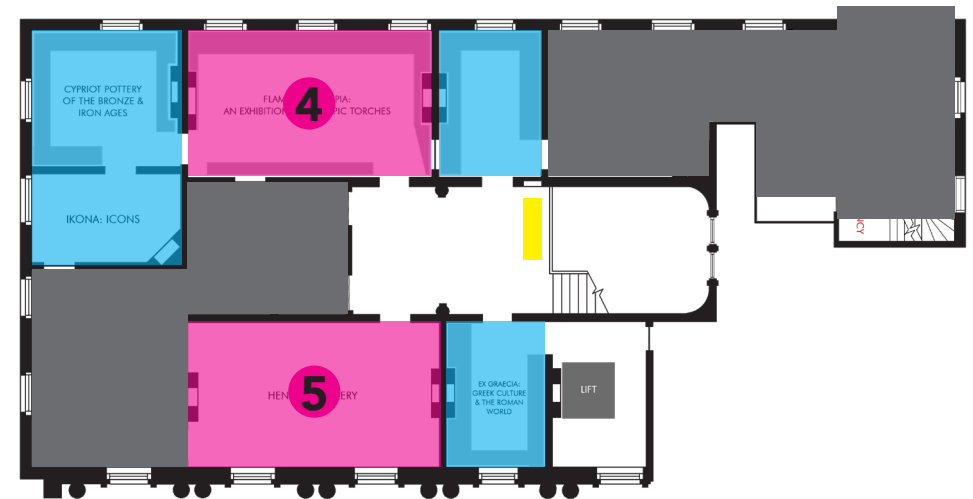


Sensory Friendly Map

-  **Low Sensory Areas**
Quiet, well-lit areas with no or low multimedia
-  **High Sensory Areas**
Areas with multimedia, noise and/or low light
-  **Seating/Rest Points**
-  **Staff Only**

-  This room has looping projector footage on the back wall, with narrated audio at speaking volume
-  This room is an old bank vault. The ceiling is standing height, but the room is narrow. The lighting is dimmed.
-  The Messenger exhibition is situated in a dark room. It is quiet except for a water pump/rippling water sound.
-  This room has a TV on the back wall, with narrated audio at speaking volume. There are virtual headsets (optional.)
-  This room has dim lighting and a low volume classical music soundtrack.
