#### Not sure where to start? Try our Highlights Tour

This simple route will guide you to some of our top picks, for a quick but solid foundation in Melbourne's Greek-influenced architecture.

Start at the Hellenic Museum

Walk, catch a La Trobe Street tram or City Loop train to **State Library Victoria** 

Walk to **Trades Hall** (optional: visit **Emily McPherson College** along the way!)

Walk to **Parliament House** (optional: visit the **Royal College of Surgeons** along the way!)

Walk or catch a Bourke Street tram to GPO

Walk to Swanston Street and catch a tram to the **Shrine of Remembrance**

#### Top tips for your journey!



Wear comfortable clothes and shoes for walking, bring a phone for navigation and QRs, and don't forget essentials like sun protection, water and snacks. You may like to bring a notebook and drawing materials for activities, too.

Hidden Hellenism is designed to be highly customisable, to suit people of all interests, ages and abilities. Which stops you visit, how you travel and the time you spend is up to you!





Walking, cycling and public transport are recommended where possible, as city driving and parking can be tricky. Always travel safely and follow the road or public transport rules.

Every location can be viewed from outside. Most can also be viewed from inside, but may be subject to opening hours or fees.\* You can find access details for each location via the map key and Digital Hub.

Families are encouraged to join! Tailor your journey to suit your needs, and engage young adventurers with the activities and prompts at each stop.

As the tour requires independently navigating the city, children should always be accompanied by an adult.
